## **Potatoes & Herring**









#### Potatoes cooked in ash

Potatoes cooked in ash are a real treat but can only be enjoyed by those who still have wooden stove at home. Other alternative is to cook the potatoes in a campfire or outside grill.



#### Fried herrin

Simple way to enjoy herring: gutted, cleaned and washed herrings are drained, filled with a bit of salt, pepper and dill to taste. Then after half an hour the herrings are fried on both sides in small amount of oil (or butter) and served immediately.
